Informed, Critical & Creative Thinking identify & solve problems using appropriate methods of inquiry, analysis, critical thinking, and creativity..



Critical Thinking - comprehensive exploration of issues, ideas, artifacts, and events before accepting or formulating opinion/conclusion

Creative Thinking - synthesis, experience, and working in imaginative way; high degree of innovation, divergent thinking & risk taking

Problem Solving - process of designing, evaluating & implementing strategy to answer open-ended question or achieve desired goal

Civic Engagement - making a difference in civic life of our communities - knowledge, skills, values, and motivation makes difference

Written Communication - development & expression of ideas in writing; involves learning to work in many genres & styles

Oral Communication - purposeful presentation to foster understanding or promote change in listener's attitudes, values, beliefs, behaviors

Information Literacy - when info needed, able to identify, locate, evaluate, and effectively & responsibly use & share info

Integrative Learning - making connections among ideas & experiences to synthesize & transfer learning to complex situations

Personal & Social Responsibility

cultivate intellectual discipline, physical and spiritual well-being, ethical engagement, and response for others within diverse communities.



Aesthetic Awareness

comprehend the nature and value of aesthetic experience and expressions.



Effective Communication

communicate effectively using a variety of methods and appropriate technologies.



Knowledge

apply knowledge acquired in their academic studies and co-curricular activities.
