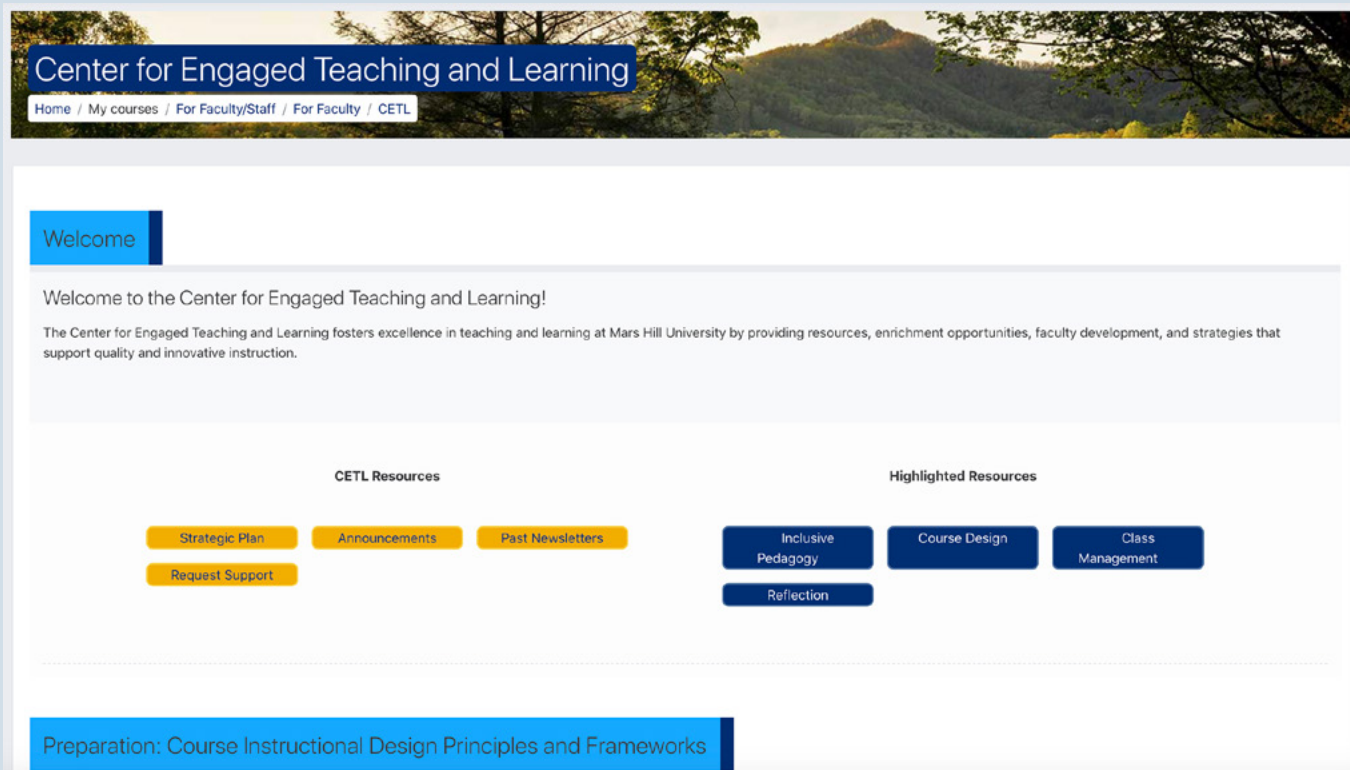
LOOKING FOR YOUR NEXT GOOD READ?
