Mighty Madison Polar Plunge Chili Cook Off Rules

Chili will be judged by “celebrity” judges 50% and the general public 50%.

The amount of tickets collected from each Chef’s jar will be used to help calculate the winner.

Tickets count as 50% of winning score. Judges scores make up 50%.

All participants must make at least four (4) quarts of chili; more can be made and sold to the general public to increase chances of winning.

The more chili you have, the more votes you are able to collect!

Contestants will not be responsible for collecting money.

How it Works!

Tickets for Chili will be sold to the general public at the main tent for \$5.00.

This fee includes a sample cup for each chili pot and a “voting ticket”.

Sample cups will then be taken to the Chili Tent.

Chefs will then give a sample of their chili to the “voter”.

After “Voters” sample chili from each chef, they will return to the Chili Tent with their voting ticket and place in desired chef’s voting jar.

Chef will then give “Voter” a cup/bowl of chili.

Chefs will be provided cups/bowls and voting jar at check-in.

Special Olympics will provide cup/bowls, spoon and sample cups.

Power will be available. Contestants are responsible for supplying extension cord for any warming devices.

Chili Cook Off will take place beneath canopy tents, tables will be provided. Seating is not; please bring your own lawn chair.

All proceeds will go to the Special Olympics of Madison County program.

The winner will receive the coveted Golden Spoon and a \$25.00 gift card to Red Lobster!
